

Spiral Cord Crochet Pattern

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Skill Level:

- Intermediate / Advanced. Crochet charts reading skill is not required.

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Materials and Tools:

- Any yarn, matching size crochet hook, tapestry needle. Shown: Bernat Maker Home Dec (72% cotton / 28% Nylon; yarn weight #5 / bulky; 8.8 oz / 250 g / 317 yds / 290 m), crochet hook G-6/4.25 mm.

US=UK crochet terminology:

sc = double crochet (dc), hdc = half treble (htr), dc = treble (tr), tr = double treble (dtr), dtr = triple treble (trtr), sk (skip) = miss, gauge = tension, yo = yarn over hook (yoh).

Flat part to attach strap to a ring or sew to a garment. Row 1: leave 20 cm / 8" end for a seam. Ch 5, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of rem 3 ch, turn. **Rows 2-10:** ch 1, sc in same st, sc in each of rem 3 sc, turn – 4 sts.



4 sts foundation leads to 8 sts (4 x 2) circumference cord.

Spiral part. Rnd 1: ch 1, BLsc in same st, BLsc in rem 3 sc,



turn. Make sc in 2nd lp of each of same 4 sc, working from other side - 8 sc.



Look at the back of sc. There are 4 lps: 2 horizontal, and 2 vertical.



Work in spiral mode, inserting hook from above in right vertical loop (if right-handed). Left-handed, work in left vertical lp.



Make 1st sc in right vertical lp of side sc.



To make 1st rnd easier, you can draw a piece of yarn through all 8 right vertical lps or place markers: 1st lp,



2nd lp,



3rd lp,



4th lp, ...



8th lp.



Rnd 2: sc in 1st lp from above,



sc in 2nd lp,



sc in 3rd lp,



sc in 4th lp.



Turn to other side, sc in 5th lp,



..., sc in 8th lp.



Completed Rnd 2.



Do not join in rnd, work in spiral mode, repeating Rnd 2.



After a few rnds, right vertical lps start to appear stretched bet sts and become easier to find.





Keep working in spiral mode until reaching desired cord length. Stop when last st is aligned with last st of Rnd 1.



Take lp off hook, insert hook in both lps (back and front) of next sc, pick up lp, and draw it through st.



Insert hook in 2 lps (1 from each side),



sc.



Repeat 2 last steps 3 times – 4 sc, turn.



Make 9 more sc rows for other end flat part. Fasten off, leaving 20 cm / 8" end for a seam
